Dual Immersion Program

History

DI Programs came into being after

- Prop. 227 eliminated Bilingual
- Education in 1998. Gilroy Unified
- School District adopted the 50/50 model first implemented in 2000-2001 school year.

In the 2006 – 2007 South Valley housed the Dual Immersion Program $6^{\text{th}} - 8^{\text{th}}$ grade; the 50/50 model was implemented in the CORE classes. Rod Kelley was the second school to start a Dual Immersion Program in the 2008-2009 school year. The program continued to Gilroy High School in 2009, and in 2013 we had our first group of graduating Senior from the very unique K-12 Dual immersion program. Gilroy Unified is one of only 5 Districts in California to offer a k-12 Dual Language Program in a unified district
